Re: Plato Solder Tips

To whom it may concern,

In reply to the many requests concerning the Recast RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU and how this affects the solder tips, Techspray is issuing this letter to explain and satisfy those requests.

First and foremost, these solder tips fall outside the scope of the directive in that they do not satisfy the definition of EEE in Article 3(1). Thus the products cannot be assigned to any of the 11 current categories in the directive.

Please rest assured that although the products fall outside the scope of the directive, they do satisfy and fall below the maximum concentrations of the six hazardous and restricted substances as outlined in Annex II:

- 1. Lead (0.1%)
- 2. Mercury (0.1%)
- 3. Cadmium (0.01%)
- 4. Hexavalent chromium (0.1%)
- 5. Polybrominated biphenyls (0.1%)
- 6. Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (0.1%)
